

Where can you park at Remarkables Primary School?

Parking is illegal on reserve areas:

- Remember that once you drive onto a grass berm or any edge of reserve, then you are parking illegally and you could be ticketed. This will be monitored in the coming months and illegally parked vehicles ticketed accordingly.
- The impact of a vehicle driving on reserves is significant. Grass areas are damaged resulting in increased maintenance costs and loss of the area can affect the whole community.
- Parking legally helps keep children safe and keeping our reserves intact respects the neighbourhood we share with our residents.
- Sometimes parking further away from the school entrance is the best solution and walking the last 5 minutes with your children to school is a safe, social and healthy start to everyone's day.

Parking in the 'kiss and drop' area:

- Double parking creates major safety hazards.
- Visibility is greatly reduced and hazards multiply.
- Children can be unpredictable, and younger siblings are often present in the drop off areas. Children are vulnerable and cannot always be seen from your vehicle.
- Having 'chaos' created in the drop off areas discourages others from walking or cycling safely to the school gate.
- Check around your vehicle/ blind spots before reversing or manoeuvring your vehicle.

What is a clearway?

There is a clearway zone outside the Early Childhood Centre on Lake Avenue. A 'clearway' means no parking is allowed in this zone during the designated hours (these are given on the clearway sign). In this area this means no parking is allowed between *8.15 and 9.15am and 2.30 and 3.30pm Monday to Friday*. Vehicles parked in the clearway zone during these times are parking illegally and may be ticketed.

Parking legally creates a safer and more pleasant environment for everyone.
Vehicles parked illegally may be ticketed.
