Confirmation of Agenda

1. Queenstown Trail Commercial Cycle Guiding Review and Relicensing (PSC 15/10B/01)

Consideration was given to a report evaluating the success of the initial term provided for commercial cycle guiding on the Queenstown Trail (QT Trails), and to approve notification of the intention to grant licences for a further term of 7 years, subject to annual renewals.

The Mayor noted that while the Queenstown Marathon had made a donation to the QT Trails there should be some further contribution for trail use as they were putting approximately 8000 people over the tracks each year during the event.

It was explained that these licences were being notified to get public feedback on how the trial period ran. If the licenses were granted the operators would be monitored and a report would come to the Property Subcommittee each year prior to renewal to ensure all conditions were being met. It was agreed that Councillors Stamers-Smith, Aoake and Ferguson sit on the hearing panel to hear any submissions. It was noted that the full terms of the licences would go to Council after the notification period.

- 3. Appoint Councillors Stamers-Smith, Aoake and Ferguson any two of which can form a hearing panel to hear any submissions.
- 4. Authorise this report and resolution to be made available to the public as part of the next Mayor's report to Council.

2. Request to Renew Reserve Licence, Liquid Expeditions Ltd (Flyboards) (PSC 15/10B/02)

Consideration was given to the renewal of a reserve licence to Liquid Expeditions Ltd over a portion of St Omer reserve. The applicants were granted a licence to occupy recreation reserve by Council in 2013 to operate "Flyboards" a water based activity from St Omer Park in Queenstown Bay, Section 2 Block XVII Town of Queenstown. This licence was renewed in 2014.

It was questioned why the applicants were only being given a 6 month term on the licence as it was likely that the Reserve Management Plan update would only place restrictions on their use of a gazebo. It was suggested that recommendation 2. be amended to make the licence period 24 months and that it be subject to any required changes to terms and conditions as a result of the Reserve Management Plan update.

The Mayor suggested that the process of report signoff could be streamlined more and provide a better level of customer service for the applicants.

On the motion of mayor van Uden and Councillor Stamers-Smith it was resolved that the Property Subcommittee:

- 1. Note the contents of this report and in particular;
- 2. Approve the renewal of the Liquid Expeditions reserve licence for a further period of 24 months over St Omer Park, Recreation Reserve Section 110 Block XX Shotover SD, with final expiry (subject to ongoing renewals) of 30 November 2023, as per the existing licence terms and conditions and subject to any required changes to terms and conditions as a result of the Reserve Management Plan update.
- 3. Recommend to Council via the next Mayor's report to Council, to exercise the Minister's

consent (under delegation from the Minister of conservation) to the granting of this licence over St Omer Park, Recreation Reserve Section 110 Block XX Shotover SD.

4. Authorise the non-commercial aspects of this report to be made available to the public as part of the next Mayor's report to Council.

3. Approval for a Donated Sculpture on Kelvin Peninsula (PSC 15/10B/03)

Consideration was given to a report that discussed the acceptance and location of a gift of public art for installation at Kelvin Peninsula in accordance with a resolution made in 2013 for the installation of ten such works of art. The request came from the Queenstown Golf Club and the Queenstown Trails Trust on behalf of Mr Hensman. The sculpture is in memory of Mr Hilton Hensman.

On the motion of Mayor van Uden and Councillor Stamers-Smith it was resolved that the Property Subcommittee:

- 1. Note the contents of this report and in particular;
- 2. Accept the gift of the Mark Hills statue from Phil Hensman to be installed on the land as shown in the attached plan.
- 3. Note that a further six pieces of art are still to be installed at some future time.
- 4. Authorise this report and resolution to be made available to the public as part of the next Mayor's report to Council.
