

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY

Frankton:

- Majority of people traveling to and from Frankton on a daily basis for work, home, recreational activities, school or shopping
- Most popular form of transport is a personal car (49%)
- Immediate need to make Frankton a great place to live include:
 - 1. High quality pedestrian and cycle routes linking key destinations
 - 2. Waterfront destinations with activities and events that will draw people in
 - 3. High frequency localised public transport connections

Active Transport:

- The trails network for fitness/fun (83%) followed by commuting for work and school (36%).
- · A combination of distance, hills and winter conditions discourages people from using the trails

Public Transport:

- High frequency of public transport systems most important, followed closely by fast journey times
- 59% preferred utilising the existing SH6A as a public transport link
- Ferry services would benefit from lower ticket sells, more convenient ferry stops and improved walking and cycling access to the jetties
- Improved public bus system, to introduce/designated bus lanes, improved transport hub and expand routes.
