Further to my earlier email, below is the response from Andy. It is unclear from this whether Abley agree that further information is required to confirm a suitable intersection location and land requirement footprint.

To address this today, MWH would like the following noted in respect to the letter:

With reference to Item 1.6 of the Abley letter to Council (Blair Devlin) dated 26 August 2013, MWH agree that the indicative land should be shown (as per Item 1.3 of the letter) but still require that this be based on achieving a compliant roundabout design. A prelim/concept design and confirmation that required sight distances can be achieved will be required to demonstrate that a compliant design can be achieved. As presented to date, and discussed at the meeting, it is not clear that a roundabout is actually a feasible mitigation measure.

We are comfortable that the reminder of the letter accurately records our meeting and agreed actions.
