MATTERS DISCUSSED

Issue 1 - Screening of Service Areas

Mr Edmonds raised his client's concern with possible back of house/servicing activities associated with the convention centre impacting upon the adjacent H W Holdings property.

Council will consider amending rule 10.6.3.2A (i) and (ii) matter of discretion for convention centres and visitor accommodation by adding the words to point (e): "and its siting proximate to adjoining properties".

Mr Edmonds agrees with Council's position, and would also prefer a rule that restricts the location of these activities where the land is used for a convention centre.
