SUMMARY STATEMENT of WARWICK PETER GOLDSMITH for ARCADIAN TRIANGLE LIMITED (SUBMISSION #497/836/1255) 18 May 2016

- 1. This Summary Statement relates to my evidence dated 21 April 2016 ("**Evidence**") given in my capacity as Director of Arcadian Triangle Limited.
- 2. I correct that Statement of Evidence as follows:
 - (a) Amend paragraph 1.5 on page 1, first sentence, (amendment underlined):
 - "1.5 This evidence is limited to Chapter 22 provisions relating to the Rural Lifestyle ("RL") zone in the Rural Landscape Classification area (not the ONL/ONF) within the Wakatipu Basin...".
 - (b) Amend paragraph 3.2 on page 10, third sentence, as follows:
 - "3.2 That rule regime has now been in place for over_almost_20 years ...".
 - (c) Amend paragraph 4.3 on page 14, second sentence, as follows:
 - "4.3 ... This proposal is therefore a fairly minor variation because all it effectively does is allow an additional laundry and kitchenthe residential flat to be larger than 70m², thereby changing a residential flat into a separate residential unit."
 - (d) Amend paragraph 4.5 on page 14, fourth sentence, as follows:
 - "4.5 ... Putting an additional kitchen and bathroom into Allowing the residential flat to be larger than 70m² will not create any perceptible difference ..."
 - (e) Schedule 2 should only contain one aerial photograph marked "B" which has a superimposed purple boundary identifying the 'Lower Shotover Triangle'. Two additional aerial photographs unrelated to the Triangle, both marked "A", were accidentally uploaded in the same link and should be removed.
- 3. I have one additional comment to make in relation to Part 4 of my Evidence on the subject of two residential units within one Residential Building Platform ("RBP").

- 4. By way of supplementary evidence, I comment on the three maps circulated (after my Evidence was lodged) with the Council Memorandum dated 29 April 2016 which show built houses and unbuilt RBPs within the Wakatipu Basin (copies **attached**):
 - (a) Map 1 (unbuilt RBPs) errors refer Area 9:
 - (i) 9 'phantom' red RBPs should be removed;
 - (ii) 9 (possibly 11) red RPBs actually contain houses (mostly competed and occupied, but three under construction) and therefore should be removed from Map 1 and included on Map 2 (as black dots identifying implemented RPBs);
 - (iii) Accordingly Area 9 overstates the unbuilt RBP position by 17 (possibly 19) future houses:
 - (iv) There are probably similar errors elsewhere for the same reasons (amended or replaced RBPs and outdated Council records).
 - (b) Map 1 the overall unbuilt RBP situation is relatively limited, which is relevant to:
 - (i) The 'potential effects' situation;
 - (ii) The 'supply' situation.
 - (c) Map 3 refer existing and rezoned RL areas largely reflects existing or consented development – limited extent of proactive supply to meet demand – potentially relevant to the 2ha v 1ha density issue.
 - (d) Map 3 query the extent to which Council's RL rezoning proposals accurately and appropriately reflect the reality on the ground; eg: refer Area 14, Area 15, Area 23.
