**MINUTE CONCERNING BERESFORD APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF
STREAM 12 HEARING DIRECTIONS (DCM REBUTTAL)**

Background

1. Our Minute of 1 May 2017 directed that rebuttal evidence on the additional material produced by Council updating the DCM Model be lodged by 1pm on 9 May 2017.
2. Counsel for Mr Beresford advises that she has requested background material breaking down the model outputs discussed in Mr Osborne's evidence for the Council and that she has been advised that this additional material will only be available today (8 May 2017).
3. She seeks an extension to 1pm Wednesday 10 May to file rebuttal evidence from Ms Hampson.
4. The brief of evidence Ms Hampson has already prepared (based on the 2015 DCM outputs) indicates that her analysis of the updated model outputs is likely to be of assistance to us. The information Counsel for Mr Beresford has sought is both relevant to Ms Hampson's rebuttal and itself likely to be of value to our understanding of the DCM model outputs.
5. We regard the 24 hour extension sought as being both modest and reasonable in the circumstances.

6. M Beresford (submitter 149) may file a rebuttal brief of evidence of Ms Natalie Hampson on the updated DCM modelling evidence lodged by the Council on or before 1pm on 10 May 2017.
