MINUTE CONCERNING CROSS BOUNDARY ONL INTEGRATION

1. As part of our review of the pre-circulated evidence in conjunction with the site visits being undertaken by the Hearing Panel this week, we have identified a potential issue concerning cross boundary integration of provisions for protection of outstanding natural landscapes in the vicinity of Lake Mackay Station.
2. Specifically, having reviewed the Central Otago District Plan ourselves, it appears that the ONL line on the CODC side of the boundary may not join the ONL line in the notified PDP at that location.
3. We would accordingly be grateful if the Council could provide us with an amended version of Figure 6 in Ms Mellsop's rebuttal evidence showing a little more of the land on the CODC side of the boundary to the east, with the ONL line(s) in the operative CODC District Plan superimposed on the amended figure in a different colour.
4. If we are correct in our reading of the CODC District Plan, and the ONL lines are indeed at materially different locations on either side of the District boundary, we would be grateful if Counsel for the Council were able to address us this coming Monday, at the commencement of the hearing, on the implications of that difference, and what, if anything, the Council proposes to do in order to address those implications. If the relevant Council witnesses can assist on the point, any verbal commentary they can provide would also be welcome.
