1. As the Earthworks Chapter (Chapter 22) is operative and not part of Stage 1 of the PDP, how is it envisaged that amendments to the PDP can achieve the benefits set out in paragraph 40?
2. To what extent are the electricity lines noted in para 47 (i.e. the Critical Electricity Lines) located within road reserve?
3. To the extent the CELs are on private land, to what extent are they authorised by easements?
4. How many designated substations are there in QL District?
5. Is there a need to distinguish between zone substations and distribution substations in your proposed rule?
6. Given your evidence about required separation distances, what is the rationale for a blanket 32 metre separation, as per Aurora's suggested rule?
