**May it please the Court**

- 1 This Memorandum of Counsel is filed on behalf of Coneburn Preserve Holdings Limited & Others (**Jacks Point**) in respect of its appeal on Stage 1 of the Queenstown Lakes Proposed District Plan (**PDP**) (ENV-2018-CHC-137).
- 2 Jacks Point wishes to amend its Notice of Appeal by withdrawing in its entirety the final appeal point included in Appendix 1 of its Notice of Appeal, which reads as follows:

*Delete the Coneburn Industrial Zone identified in planning map 13 and Chapter 44 of the PDP; or*

*Amend Chapter 44 subject to further refinements to the objectives, policies and rules which ensure that adverse effects on amenity, visual character, landscape, transport, noise, and traffic on the JPZ are adequately addressed.*
- 3 An amended Notice of Appeal is lodged with this Memorandum, showing a tracked change version as "Appendix A" and a clean version as "Appendix B".
- 4 As Jacks Point was the only appellant seeking relief to Chapter 44 (Coneburn Industrial Zone) of the PDP, it is Jacks Point's understanding that its withdrawal of the appeal point set out above resolves all matters allocated to Topic 9 (Coneburn Industrial Zone) of Stage 1 of the DPR.
