- 1 Revell and Victoria Buckham (The Buckhams) wish to be a party pursuant to section 274 of the RMA to the following proceedings:
 - Arthurs Point Protection Society v Queenstown Lakes District Council (ENV-2018-CHC-000067) being an appeal against decisions of Queenstown Lakes District Council on the proposed Queenstown Lakes District Plan (PDP).
- The Buckhams made a submission about the subject matter of the proceedings.
- The Buckhams are not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the RMA.

 - (a) Is not effects-based planning which is envisaged under the RMA, and is contrary to the intent of the introduced informal airport activity rules.
 - (b) Ignores significant evidence presented in the PDP which supported the application of NZS 6807 to measure helicopter noise and the appropriateness of the averaging method.
