    Council [ENV-2018-CHC-117]

  - (c) Aurora seeks to ensure that the Proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement which recognises and protects Aurora's Electricity

Sub-transmission Infrastructure and Significant Electricity Distribution Infrastructure will be given effect to.

- (d) Aurora seek to ensure that development of electrical infrastructure can occur efficiently to support development within ski area subzones/Cardrona Alpine Resort.
- 6. The Applicant agrees to participate in mediation or alternative dispute resolution
