The submitter requests that the planning decision for Plan Change 50 (Queenstown Town Centre Extension) is incorporated into the Proposed District Plan.

The submitter opposes the proposed height limit for the property located at 10 Man Street (legally described as Section 6 Block IX Town of Queenstown). In the Proposed District Plan, the property at 10 Man Street is contained within the Queenstown Town Centre Zone, and in particular Height Precinct 1. The submitter requests that the height limit for 10 Man Street should be the same as that proposed for Height Precinct 7 (Man Street), being a maximum height of 11 metres above the existing ground level (for the property located at 10 Man Street).

  - 5.1 That Plan Change 50 is incorporated into the Proposed District Plan
  - 5.5 That the building height limit for 10 Man Street is the same as the height limit for Height Precinct 7 (Man Street).
