

Parking changes to Frankton

In order to ensure long term parking on SH6 doesn't shift into residential areas, the existing 48 hr parking restrictions will be extended to include residential Frankton west of Kawarau Road.

Soon, new restrictions will stop cars parking on the roadside and verges along SH6 from the Kawarau Fall bridge, past the BP Roundabout to the Shotover Bridge. Cars parked in these areas have become an eyesore and a traffic hazard.

In June an airport park and ride service will begin operation with a regular shuttle running between Queenstown Airport and a dedicated carpark on Brookes Road.

This winter a temporary link will open up between Glenda Drive and Frankton. This will allow traffic to travel this way until Hawthorne Drive is completed at the end of the year.
