May it please the Panel

1. The Hearings Panel Chair has granted an extension of time to Trojan Helmet Limited (THL) (Submitter 2387) in which to file its landscape, masterplanning and planning evidence, which evidence will respond to the Council's planning and landscape evidence. The Council's evidence was filed late, hence the extension for THL.
2. By way of this memorandum, THL seeks an extension of time in which to file evidence of one further witness, namely Anna-Marie Chin, Architect. Ms Chin's evidence will describe building design guidelines which will be proposed to address some of the concerns raised by the Council's landscape witness, Ms Gilbert, in her evidence, in particular, her concerns in respect of effects on visitors to the proposed Resort.
3. It is therefore respectfully submitted that it would be fair and reasonable to provide an extension of time for Ms Chin's evidence, given the lateness of Ms Gilbert's evidence.
4. For the avoidance of doubt, an extension of time is sought until 4pm Tuesday, 19 June 2018 in which to file Ms Chin's evidence. It is anticipated that Ms Chin's evidence will be very brief.
