Variation 1 - Arrowtown Design Guidelines 2016

Queenstown Lakes District Council gives public notice as of **20 July 2016** of Variation 1 to the Proposed District Plan - Arrowtown Design Guidelines 2016.

The purpose of Variation 1 is to incorporate the Arrowtown Design Guidelines 2016 into the Proposed District Plan and to update references to the Arrowtown Design Guidelines 2006 in five separate chapters of the Proposed District Plan, with the Arrowtown Design Guidelines 2016. The new guidelines are based on the 2006 guidelines but have been revised and updated to reflect changes that have occurred in Arrowtown since 2006. They also provide guidance for development in the proposed zones set out in the Proposed District Plan.

What happens next?

Following the receipt of public submissions, a summary of the decisions requested will be prepared. This will then be publicly notified for further submissions. You can only make a further submission if you represent a relevant aspect of the public interest (e.g. A community association or environmental organisation) or have an interest in the Variation that is greater than the general public (e.g. the Variation affects your property rights).

The Council has appointed Commissioners to hear submissions on the Proposed District Plan, including this proposed Variation. Following the close of the further submission period, a public hearing will be held to enable submitters to present their submissions.
